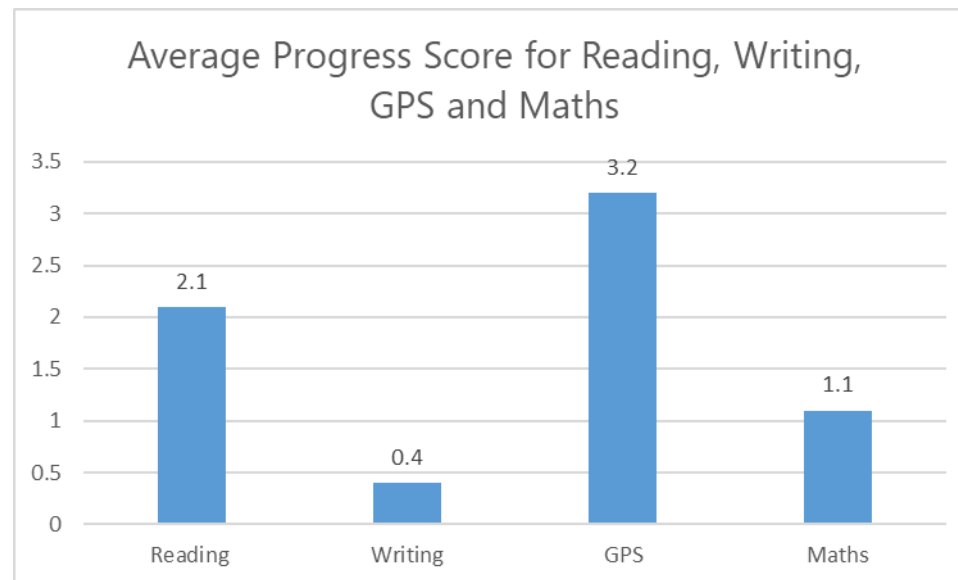

Average Progress for Reading, Writing, GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling) and Mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2

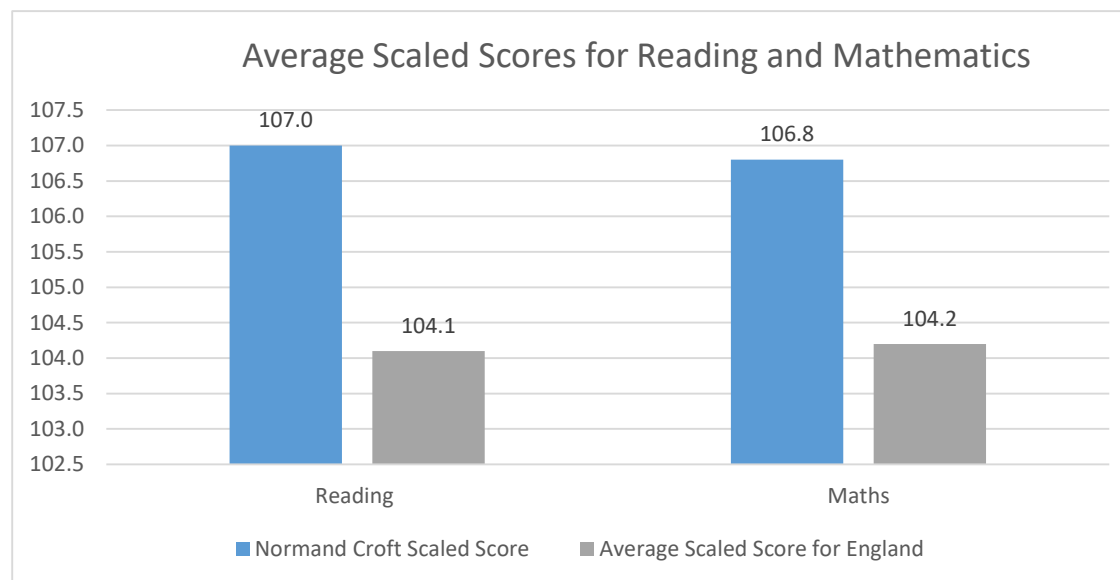
This score is a measure of progress from the end of Year 2 until the end of Year 6. A progress score of zero means that on average pupils achieved similar results at the end of Year 2 to similar pupils at the end of Year 6. A positive score means pupils made better than average progress.



Average Scaled Scores for Reading and Maths at the End of Key Stage 2

Scaled scores are standardised against all schools in the country. The scores go from 0 to 120 and represents the marks from the SATs tests.
