
## Be Safe, Be Kind, Be The Best That You Can Be Early Years and Primary Learning

This week in Nursery our topic is dinosaurs. We talked about how we have an idea of what dinosaurs looked like because of the fossils people have found. Here we are using salt dough and our toy dinosaurs to make our own fossils.



In Reception this week we have been busy preparing for our Platinum Jubilee celebration on Friday. We have learnt all about Queen Elizabeth and we have made some royal crowns and flags

Year One designed and had a go at making boats. They had to use their problem solving skills as well as thinking about how they would have a Mr Bounce attitude. After making them we tested them out to see if the boats were able to float in the water. In Maths we have been looking at sharing equally between groups and have been getting very impressive at counting in 2s, 5s and 10s!



This week in Year 2, we have started our new topic of measurement in maths. We have been learning how to measure length and height with not only rulers but other objects too such as cubes. We learnt that they have to be the same size and object that we measure with at a time. Also, we have been celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee by decorating our classroom with bunting, paper chains, balloons and creating our own British flags. We got to celebrate by having an afternoon tea in the playground with the whole school!

Year 3 have been learning about life in the 1950s and produced some lovely decorations including some 'Jubilee Planters'.

Year 4 have been enjoying their science topic about electricity. They have been experimenting with equipment to make a working circuit and light up a bulb. After they had to try and incorporate a working switch into their circuits.

This week in English, Year 5 have been writing a diary as if they were Perce Blackborow. He was a stowaway who smuggled himself onto Sir Ernest Shackleton's ship - the Endurance. We have had great fun acting out the scenes to help us understand what he endured and how he may have felt.
